FOCUS OF CHAPTER

As Jesus foretold, his people face legal
opposition to their preaching work

Paragraph 24

(Acts 5:29) In answer Peter and the other
apostles said: "We must obey God as ruler

(Matthew 28:19, 20) Go, therefore, and make
disciples of people of all the nations, baptizing
them in the name of the Father and of the Son
and of the holy spirit, 20 teaching them to

Paragraph 27

(Acts 1:8) But you will receive power when the
holy spirit comes upon you, and you will be
witnesses of me in Jerusalem, in all Ju·de'a
and Sa·mar'i-a, and to the most distant part of
the earth."

Paragraph 31

(Daniel 2:21) He changes times and seasons,
Removes kings and sets up kings, Gives
wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those
with discernment.

Paragraph 32

(Isaiah 52:10) Jehovah has bared his holy arm
before the eyes of all the nations; All the ends
of the earth will see the acts of salvation of our
God.
