The yeartext selected for 2019 gives us three reasons why we can remain calm even when bad things happen in the world or in our personal life. This article will examine those reasons and help us to feel less anxious and more inclined to trust in Jehovah. Meditate on the yeartext. Memorize it if you can. - The expression "Do not be afraid" is mentioned three times, at Isaiah 41:10, 13, and 14. The same verses frequently mention the word "I" (referring to Jehovah). Why did Jehovah inspire Isaiah to use "I" so frequently? To highlight an important fact—we can calm our fears only by trusting in Jehovah.
- (Isaiah 41:10) Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not be anxious, for I am your God. I will fortify you, yes, I will help you, I will really hold on to you with my right hand of righteousness.'
- (Isaiah 41:13) For I, Jehovah your God, am grasping your right hand, The One saying to you, 'Do not be afraid. I will help you.'
- (Isaiah 41:14) Do not be afraid, you worm Jacob, You men of Israel, I will help you," declares Jehovah, your Repurchaser, the Holy One of Israel.

(Isaiah 43:4) For you became precious in my eyes, You were honored, and I have loved you. So I will give people in place of you And nations in exchange for your life.

(Isaiah 54:10) For the mountains may be removed And the hills may be shaken, But my loyal love will not be removed from you, Nor will my covenant of peace be shaken," says Jehovah, the One having mercy on you.
