Are you comfortable? [Matt takes a selfie] Happy anniversary. [Sometime later and Lauren is clearly unwell] Are you all right? [The alarm goes off and Matt is alone in bed and reaches over to where Lauren would have been sleeping – he touches his wedding ring and gets up to go into field service] [At the field service group – Matt appears distant] In our field ministry this weekend, to offer the current magazine, which one of those do you think that you'd like to use? [Brother Tobias taps Matt on the shoulder and invites him to accompany him in the ministry] So before we go in the territory, do you mind if we make a stop first? No, I haven't seen him.

They received some bad news today, so really— Uh, there they are.

Our first part tonight will be handled by Brother Javier Vallez.

It's, ah— It's the— Uh, well, maybe it's better if I just read it from the reference, um, yeah, it's the 2011 Watchtower.

So we had a great meeting.

Let's conclude with song and prayer.

Amen.

[Matt goes to the carpark trying to catch up with Javier]
[Matt at Javier and Michelle Vallez's home]

[Levi leaves his seat – Javier notices him leaving]

[At Javier and Michelle's new home – moving furniture]

Did you get to talk to Levi?

No. But, you know, I did talk to his mom. You know, she said that the divorce has been really difficult.

You know, we can do something.

[At the Kingdom Hall – Javier invites Levi to a return visit (Robert)]

Hey, you know, I met a young man the other day, and he's about your age.

[At Robert's home]

Hey, Robert.

How are you?

Good.

[Levi shows a video to Robert]

[At Javier and Michelle's home]

I'm really glad you like Chinese food, Levi.

Are you kidding me? We used to eat Chinese food all the time with— I-I can't believe he left.

SCENARIO 3

[At the kingdom Hall]

We've had a ton of leaves falling in our yard that needed cleaning up, and I thought I'd see if you needed some help around here.

Far be it for me to refuse free help.

[Levi is raking leaves and Brother Tobias calls him]

Levi, come.

[Inside Levi and Brother Tobias enjoy a sandwich together]

[Levi looks at the photos on the wall and gestures to Brother Tobias who gives the OK for Levi to have a look]

So you went to Bethel? then Gilead?

I did.

I want to go Bethel someday. Javier and Michelle, they took me not that long ago, and I really liked what I saw.

That is an excellent goal. <u>You'll never go wrong putting spiritual things first</u> in your life.

I'll be back tomorrow to finish up the leaves.

Sounds good.

I'll have the hot chocolate ready.

[Levi at home in his bedroom looks fondly at a photo of him and Bro Tobias and reflects on Javier's words]

You and your mom are never alone. We're all part of Jehovah's family.
