- (John 8:29) And the One who sent me is with me; he did not abandon me to myself, because I always do the things pleasing to him."

- (John 15:8) My Father is glorified in this, that you keep bearing much fruit and prove yourselves my disciples.

4. How can we please Jehovah in all aspects of our life? (John 14:31; Eph. 6:1-4; Ps. 35:18; 1 Pet. 2:12)

- (John 14:31) But for the world to know that I love the Father, I am doing just as the Father has commanded me to do. Get up, let us go from here.
- (Ephesians 6:1-4) Children, be obedient to your parents in union with the Lord, for this is righteous. 2 "Honor your father and your mother" is the first command with a promise: 3 "That it may go well with you and you may remain a long time

FIND ANSWERS TO THESE QUESTIONS:

1. What are three provisions from Jehovah that bring us joy? (Ps. 32:1-10)

(Psalm 32:1-10) Happy is the one whose transgression is pardoned, whose sin is covered. 2 Happy is the man whom Jehovah does not charge with guilt, In whose spirit there is no deceit. 3 When I kept silent, my bones wasted away because of my groaning all day long. 4 For day and night your hand was heavy upon me. My strength evaporated like water in the dry summer heat. (Selah) 5 Finally I confessed my sin to you; I did not cover my error. I said: "I will confess my transgressions to Jehovah." And you pardoned the error of my sins. (Selah) 6 This is why every loyal one will pray to you While you may yet be found. Then even the floodwaters will not reach him. 7 You are a hiding place for me; You will safeguard me from distress. You will surround me with joyful shouts of deliverance. (Selah) 8 "I will give you insight and instruct you in the way you should go. I will give you advice with my eye upon you. 9 Do not become like a horse or a mule, without understanding, Whose spiritedness must be controlled with a bridle or a halter Before it will come near to you." 10 Many are the pains of the wicked; But the one trusting in Jehovah is surrounded by His loyal love.

2. How can we find joy now? (Ps. 5:11, 12; 91:14)

(Psalm 5:11, 12) But all those who take refuge in you will rejoice; They will always shout joyfully. You will block approach to them, And those loving your name will rejoice in you. 12 For you will bless anyone righteous, O Jehovah; You will surround them with approval as with a large shield.

(Psalm 91:14) God said: "Because he has affection for me, I will rescue him. I will protect him because he knows my name."

3. How can we maintain our joy in the ministry despite challenges? (Acts 13:50-52; Rom. 5:3-5)

(Acts 13:50-52) But the Jews incited the prominent women who were God-fearing and the principal men of the city, and they stirred up persecution against Paul and Bar'na·bas and threw them outside their boundaries. 51 So they shook the dust off their feet against them and went to I-co'ni-um. 52 And the disciples continued to be filled with joy and holy spirit.

(Romans 5:3-5) Not only that, but let us rejoice while in tribulations, since we know that tribulation produces endurance; 4 endurance, in turn, an approved condition; the approved condition, in turn, hope, 5 and the hope does not lead to disappointment; because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the holy spirit, which was given to us.

4. How can we avoid 'becoming weighed down' and losing our joy? (Luke 21:34)

(Luke 21:34) "But pay attention to yourselves that your hearts never become weighed down with overeating and heavy drinking and anxieties of life, and suddenly that day be instantly upon you

5. How does Jehovah make us rejoice? (Ps. 92:4, 5)

(Psalm 92:4, 5) For you have made me rejoice, O Jehovah, because of your deeds; Because of the works of your hands I shout joyfully. 5 How great your works are, O Jehovah! How very deep your thoughts are!

6. What will help us to keep Jehovah before us constantly? (Rom. 1:20; Deut. 6:6-9; Phil. 4:6; Ps. 16:3)

(Romans 1:20) For his invisible qualities are clearly seen from the world's creation onward, because they are perceived by the things made, even his eternal power and Godship, so that they are inexcusable.

(Deuteronomy 6:6-9) These words that I am commanding you today must be on your heart, 7 and you must inculcate them in your sons and speak of them when you sit in your house and when you walk on the road and when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as a reminder on your hand, and they must be like a headband on your forehead. 9 Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

(Philippians 4:6) Do not be anxious over anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication along with thanksgiving, let your petitions be made known to God;

(Psalm 16:3) And the holy ones in the earth, The majestic ones, bring me great delight.”


