Paragraph 3

- **(Ezekiel 36:23)** ‘I will certainly sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the nations, which you profaned among them; and the nations will have to know that I am Jehovah,’ declares the Sovereign Lord Jehovah, ‘when I am sanctified among you before their eyes.
- **(Matthew 6:9)** “You must pray, then, this way: “Our Father in the heavens, let your name be sanctified.
- **(Job 2:3, 4)** And Jehovah said to Satan: “Have you taken note of my servant Job? There is no one like him on the earth. He is an upright man of integrity, fearing God and shunning what is bad. He is still holding firmly to his integrity, even though you try to incite me against him to destroy him for no reason.”⁴ But Satan answered Jehovah: “Skin for skin. A man will give everything that he has for his life.
- **(Job 27:5)** It is unthinkable for me to declare you men righteous! Until I die, I will not renounce my integrity!

(Matthew 6:9) “You must pray, then, this way: “Our Father in the heavens, let your name be sanctified.

Paragraph 6

(Proverbs 22:1) A good name is to be chosen rather than great wealth; To be respected is better than silver and gold.

(Ecclesiastes 7:1) A good name is better than good oil, and the day of death is better than the day of birth.

Paragraph 8

(Genesis 1:26-28) Then God said: “Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness, and let them have in subjection the fish of the sea and the flying creatures of the heavens and the domestic animals and all the earth and every creeping animal that is moving on the earth.”
27 And God went on to create the man in his image, in God’s image he created him; male and female he created them. 28 Further, God blessed them, and God said to them: “Be fruitful and become many, fill the earth and subdue it, and have in subjection the fish of the sea and the flying creatures of the heavens and every living creature that is moving on the earth.”

(Genesis 2:18) Then Jehovah God said: “It is not good for the man to continue to be alone. I am going to make a helper for him, as a complement of him.”

Paragraph 9

(Genesis 2:16, 17) Jehovah God also gave this command to the man: “From every tree of the garden you may eat to satisfaction. 17 But as for the tree of the knowledge of good and bad, you must not eat from it, for in the day you eat from it you will certainly die.”

(Genesis 3:1-5) Now the serpent was the most cautious of all the wild animals of the field that Jehovah God had made. So it said to the woman: “Did God really say that you must not eat from every tree of the garden?”
2 At this the woman said to the serpent: “We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden.
3 But God has said about the fruit of the tree that is in the middle of the garden: ‘You must not eat from it, no, you must not touch it; otherwise you will die.’”
4 At this the serpent said to the woman: “You certainly will not die.
5 For God knows that in the very day you eat from it, your eyes will be opened and you will be like God, knowing good and bad.”

(Genesis 2:9) Thus Jehovah God made to grow out of the ground every tree that was pleasing to look at and good for food and also the tree of life in the middle of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and bad.

Paragraph 10

(Genesis 3:2-4) At this the woman said to the serpent: “We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden. 3 But God has said about the fruit of the tree that is in the middle of the garden: ‘You must not eat from it, no, you must not touch it; otherwise you will die.’” 4 At this the serpent said to the woman: “You certainly will not die.

(1 Timothy 2:14) Also, Adam was not deceived, but the woman was thoroughly deceived and became a transgressor.

(Genesis 3:6) Consequently, the woman saw that the tree was good for food and that it was something desirable to the eyes, yes, the tree was pleasing to look at. So she began taking of its fruit and eating it. Afterward, she also gave some to her husband when he was with her, and he began eating it.

(Proverbs 27:11) Be wise, my son, and make my heart rejoice, So that I can make a reply to him who taunts me.

(Psalm 146:5, 6) Happy is the one who has the God of Jacob as his helper, Whose hope is in Jehovah his God, 6 The Maker of heaven and

earth, Of the sea, and of all that is in them, The One who always remains faithful,

(Psalm 146:10) Jehovah will be King forever, Your God, O Zion, for generation after generation. Praise Jah!

Paragraph 17
